# **Becoming UT student (1)**

#### **BEFORE 02.09.2024 YOU CAN:**

- receive the UT email address (firstname.lastname@ut.ee), through which takes place communication with university; UT email address is created automatically for international degree and exchange students;
- sign up for courses in the <u>Study Information</u>
  <u>System</u> (SIS);
- apply for the Estonian ID code in <u>Tartu Welcome</u> <u>Centre</u>. NB! Getting an Estonian ID code is mandatory for all students.

#### **AS OF 02.09.2024 YOU CAN:**

- update your profile information in SIS. PS! All students must enter their contact details;
- continue planning the courses; the registration and cancellation are open until **September 16**;
- ask for **proof of study document** from the <u>Dean's</u> <u>Office</u>. Please send a request by email first.



# **Becoming UT student (2)**


- ➤ There is no specific registration process for getting the student status;
- There is no UT student card, no physical nor electronic;
- If you need to proove your student status, then you can ask by email your **proof of study document** (electronic or physical) from the Dean's Office (contacts can be found <u>here</u>);
- > Students usually use (virtual) ISIC card. For instructions, please see **Arrival ABC**.





## **User account**

> Entering UT **Study Information System** with UT username and password: guidelines are <u>here</u>.

## **Course registration**

All students must register for courses they want to take at UT;

New students have until 16.09.2024 to register for courses, as well as to cancel the registrations;

Once the registration deadline is over, you cannot sign up or cancel the registrations yourself;

# Course-load for exchange students

- ➤ Minimum requirement of UT: **at least 15 ECTS per semester** (except PhD and traineeship students);
- > Exchange students usually complete about 20-30 ECTS per semester;
- Check also the requirements of your home University;
- > Do not forget to cancel registration, if you don't plan to attend a course. NB! If you don't attend a course and don't cancel the registration before the deadline, then you will receive a negative grade for that course;

## **Exams and assessment**

- ➤ A course is considered completed after obtaining positive result in the assessment of learning outcomes (exam/test/any other form of assignment);
- > The scales for the assessment of learning outcomes:
- o differentiated (grades A, B, C, D, E, F);
- o non-differentiated (pass/fail).
- The assessment type assigned to a course cannot be changed;
- Grades and credits appear in SIS sometime after the exams.
