What should I know before
registering?

- Classes take place **once or twice a week**
- They last for **one semester**
- **Participation** in classes is usually a **requirement for passing the course**

- Check your registrations in the SIS for **cancelling dates**
- **Register early** to ensure your spot

- **Autumn** semester begins in September
- **Spring** semester begins in February
