
Where is Tartu?

- With a population of 95.000, Tartu is the second largest city in Estonia
- Every fifth resident is a student or works for UT
- Known as the Intellectual Capital of Estonia and the City of Youth
- A cozy and compact town with a safe living and study environment and active cultural life

- Belongs to **350 the world's best universities**
- Est. **1632**
- 14 800 students, 11% international students
 from over 100 countries
- Highest ranked university and leading research centre in Estonia

- 32 international degree programmes
- International environment

Health

- Search for a Family doctor at <u>Estonian Health</u> <u>Board</u> and register for one.
- For doctor's visit: European Health Insurance Card or private insurance (for example, Ergo, Swiss care, AS Inges Kindlustus, AON)
- Emergency room in Tartu 5 EUR for a visit
- Psychological Counselling at UT

- Drugstores sell both non-prescription and prescription medicinal products.
- You can always ask for advice from the pharmacist to help you choose the best medication.
- Not all medications are available in Estonia, but they might be available in other countries. Check the medications available in Estonia and compare the prices of different drug stores <u>here</u> (web page in Estonian language).
- Find the closest drugstore to you<u>here</u>. Raekoja pharmacy is opened 24/7 and situated at Town Hall.

- You can also just swipe your bank card (1.5 euro)
- Purchase monthly tickets at Tartu Information Centre: youth (under 26) – 12.95 EUR, regular – 18.5 EUR
