# What should I know before registering?

- Classes take place once or twice a week
- They last for one semester
- Participation in classes
  is usually a
  requirement for
  passing the course



- If the course is full,
   register for the waiting
   list
- Check your registrations in the SIS for cancelling dates
- Register early to ensure your spot



- Registration usually

   opens on 15 May and
   15 December and stays

   open until the semester
   starts
- Autumn semester
   begins in September
- Spring semester begins in February
