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What should I know before  
registering?

- Classes take place **once or twice a week**

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- **Registration usually opens** on 15 May and 15 December and stays open until the semester starts

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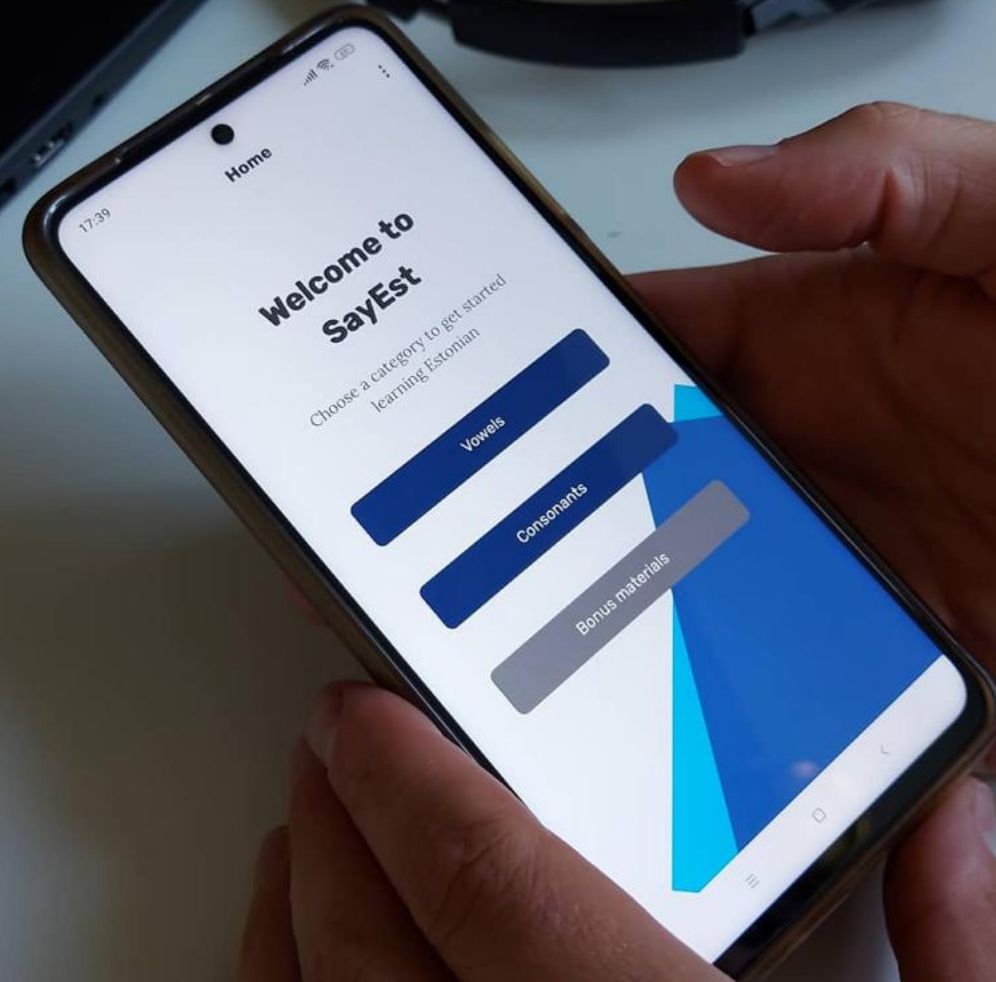
