SAFETY



From the police point of view is Tartu a relatively peaceful community with a small number of serious crimes. Main problem is alcohol.

TRAFFIC



It's NOT ALLOWED TO:

- Cross the road when the traffic light is **red**
- Ride with a bicycle on the pavement if there are no special signs
- Drink and drive (0 tolerance)



Things that You MUST HAVE or MUST DO:

- Wear a reflector when it is dark outside
- Use the seatbelt when You are in the car
- As a driver, use a hands-free device
- Car lights have to be turned on when You are driving



DRINKING AND SMOKING



Drinking:

- ✓ It is not allowed to drink alcohol in public places if it is disturbing others
- ✓ You can buy, own and drink alcohol when You are 18 years old
- ✓ Do not come to the public areas if You are too drunk (bad coordination etc)



DRINKING AND SMOKING



Smoking:

- ◆ You can smoke in the public areas but inside the buildings You are allowed to smoke only in the designated areas
- ◆ You can buy, own and use tobacco products when You are 18 years old



PUBLIC ORDER



You are violating the public order if You:

- ✓ Make noise in the public area
- ✓ Pee in the public area
- ✓ Harass other people (talk to them if they do not want that etc)
- ✓ Play music in Your car or apartment so loudly that it is annoying others



Punishment: max 800euros or 30 days in the jail

PUNISHMENTS



Violation of law	Fine
Drinking or being too drunk in a public area	800euros or 30 days in jail
Smoking in a prohibited area	160euros
Using or owning a small amount of drugs	1600euros or 30 days in jail
Crossing the road in a wrong place / not wearing a reflector	80euros
Stealing a thing what costs less that 200€	2400euros or 30 days in jail
Hurting someone / violating public order in a group	criminal punishment
Racial violence if the person's life or property is under danger	2400euros or 30 days in jail
Insult (name, race etc)	administrative court case

NB: these are maximum punishments. There is usually a warning before the fine!

RECOMMENDATIONS



- ◆ Do not leave things in a visible place in the car
- ◆ Guard Your things (bag, wallet) in public areas
- ◆ Lock Your bicycle, car and apartment
- ◆ Acknowledge and accept all the differences
- ◆ If You do not know the law, ask for help

**Not knowing the law is not an excuse
for breaking the law. Follow the law!**

Possible power outage and how to deal with it



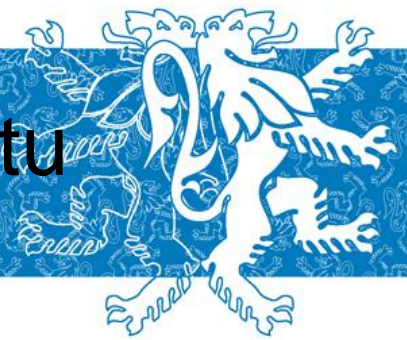
- Estonia, together with Latvia and Lithuania, is preparing to synchronize the electricity grid of the Baltic countries with the continental European electricity grid on February 9, 2025, in order to take a big step forward in energy security.
- The danger level is low at the moment, but you have to be ready

We recommend that each person:



- Think about what it means for you and your family if there is no electricity, water and/or heating at home.
- Prepare to manage independently at home for at least a week.
- Keep supplies at home based on your needs: water, food, medicines and other things you need.
- Keep a small amount of cash in your wallet so that you can make the necessary purchases in the store
- If you have, charge your power bank
